CHOOSING THE RIGHT SIZE & LAYOUT

Before you jump into designs or permits, let's take a step back. Start by thinking about what your building needs to do.

Is this for hay storage? Equipment? A covered area for livestock or a full riding arena? Your layout should match your land, your operation, and your future plans — not someone else's one-size-fits-all design.

RULES OF THUMB

Small livestock/hay storage = 24' x 30' or 30' x 40'

Tractor + implements = 40' x 60' with 14'-16' sidewalls

Mixed-use barn (stalls + storage) = 40' x 80' or larger

Indoor riding arena (single horse width) = 60' x 120' minimum

Add height = Go 16'-18' sidewalls for overhead doors or tall equipment

Plan for the future — Most clients say they wish they had gone bigger — even with open land, it's easier to expand now than retrofit later.
